



## CACCN Membership Definitions

(CACCN Constitution and Bylaws, Article II – Membership, Section 1 – Classes of Members, 1.11 to 1.15 and 1.2)

**ACTIVE MEMBER:** Any registered nurse, with an interest in critical care, who possess a current and valid licence or certificate in the province, territory or country in which the registered nurse practises.

---

**STUDENT MEMBER:** Any student nurse in an accredited professional nursing program, who is currently not licensed as a registered nurse or graduate nurse.

---

**LIFE MEMBER:** Any member in the association who has made significant contributions to the association as determined by the board may be provided Life Member status.

---

**ASSOCIATE MEMBER:** Any person with an interest in critical care, but who does not meet the requirements for an ACTIVE MEMBER.

---

**HONOURARY MEMBER:** Persons who are not otherwise eligible for membership in the Association and whom the Association wishes to honour.

---

**INTERNATIONAL MEMBERS:** International Members who meet the Active member designation will have access to all CACCN benefits however may not hold office or serve on committees at the National level.
