“Specialty Orientation Program”

The Critical Care Clinical Network – Education Team, Specialty Orientation Program was developed for nurses entering critical care in the Province of Alberta to be delivered via telehealth.

Members from thirteen hospitals across five provincial zones with critical care units developed the project following a survey of many orientation programs across Canada and the United States.

A priority was placed on developing a consistent, evidence-based orientation program; a nurse moving from one hospital to another (within or outside a zone) would only require very unit-specific orientation to be an independent member of the new unit thanks to consistency in initial critical care education.
